Cigi McCollin Becomes Second Hofstra Player to Win Award this Season

BETHESDA, MD (6 February 2006) – **Cigi McCollin (Long Island City, NY/Christ the King)** led Hofstra University (12-8 Overall, 7-4 Colonial Athletic Association) to a 1-1 week en route to being the second Hofstra student-athlete to earn the PrestoSports/MBWA Player of the Week Award this season. In a 69-62 loss at William & Mary, McCollin chipped in with eight points, two rebounds and three assists in 23 minutes of action. Then against UNC Wilmington, a 91-76 win, the junior guard poured in a career-high 34 points on 13-of-14 shooting from the field, including eight-of-nine from beyond the three-point arc. McCollin scored 17 points in each half and played a total of 35 minutes in the contest as Hofstra earned the 15-point victory. Her 34 points are the eighth-most in a single game in Hofstra basketball history and the eight three-pointers are the most by a Pride player this season. In addition, her 92.9% shooting from the field tied her for fifth in the nation on this season's highest single game field goal percentage list. McCollin is also second on Hofstra's all-time three-pointer list.

PRESTOSPORTS/MBWA MEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK Saint Peter's Keydren Clark Earns Award for Second Time this Season

BETHESDA, MD (6 February 2006) – Saint Peter's College took a big step forward this week, winning a trio of Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference games. The Peacocks were led by **Keydren Clark (Harlem, NY/Rice)**, who earns the PrestoSports/MBWA Player of the Week Award for the second time this season. The Peacocks (12-10 Overall, 8-5 MAAC) won at first-place Iona, 76-74, at Marist, 75-74, and at home against Siena, 81-63. The 5'10" 160 lbs. guard averaged 27.3 points per game, while adding 10 rebounds and 11 assists during the week. Against Iona, he connected on all four free throw attempts he had in the final 26 seconds to cement the two-point win. Three days later, he hit a 10-foot floater off the backboard at the buzzer to give Saint Peter's a 75-74 win. Against Siena, his 23 points led all scorers as the Peacocks routed Siena. For his efforts, the MAAC also named Clark its Player of the Week.
