We have designed this brochure to provide you with the pertinent information necessary to make your trip as easy and enjoyable as possible. If there are any questions that are not answered in this brochure, feel free to contact any one on our staff.

FACILITIES

Location:

Hayes Gymnasium Intercollegiate Athletic Training Room is located on the first level across from the basketball court.

EVENT MEDICAL STAFF:

- A) Certified Athletic Trainer
- B) Team Orthopedist: on-call status
- C) Athletic Training Student Assistants: as assigned

Hours:

2 hours before game; approximately 1 hour after completion.

TAPING:

Should your team be traveling without an athletic trainer:

- 1) Team should provide their own taping supplies
- 2) All services will be provided by our Sports Medicine Staff
- 3) Prior notification is recommended
- 4) Written requests required for modality treatments

TREATMENTS:

- 1) Ice: crushed and ice massage
- 2) Hydrocollator
- 3) Ultrasound/Electric stim: written request required if traveling without an ATC

EQUIPMENT:

Crutches/Splints/etc.

EVENT SUPPLIES:

For your convenience, we will provide on each team bench:

- 1) Ice water and cups
- 2) Ice chest with bags
- 3) AED –available on home bench only
- 4) Bio-hazard materials –available on home bench only
- 5) Crutches/splints –available on home bench only

Outdoor Events:

- Water/ice/taping tables (1) will be available

Sideline:

- 2-10 gallons of water-refilled as needed with cups
- Ice chest
- 10 gallons of water for halftime
- Team Physician may be available for all home games
- AED –available on home bench only
- Crutches/splints –available on home bench only
